Peroxiredoxin I (PrxI) is a typical 2-Cys peroxiredoxin that plays important roles in protecting cells from oxidative stress. However, it has also been found that the PrxI is truncated from its C-terminal portion in some pathogens, which possess this truncation. In this study, we identified that the C-terminal truncation of PrxI activates its peroxidase activity, although the two cysteine residues are still present in the truncated enzyme. Site-directed mutagenesis revealed that two conserved cysteine residues, C132 and C137, are responsible for the C-terminal truncation-induced activation of its peroxidase activity. In addition, the C132S mutation greatly reduced the truncation-induced peroxidase activity, whereas the C137S mutation markedly enhanced this activity. When the two cysteine residues in the truncated enzyme were replaced by glycine, the peroxidase activity was completely abolished. These results indicate that the two cysteine residues are crucial for the peroxidase activity of the truncated PrxI. Our findings demonstrate that the C-terminal truncation of PrxI activates its peroxidase activity, leading to the accumulation of hydrogen peroxide and causing damage to cells.
