
A simple macro program which creates a custom shortcut for launching any executable file. Access key and all information What is it? Windows-only. Mac OS X version available. Windows-only. Mac OS X version available. How does it work? Essentially, this program is a small program which runs under the hood of Windows or OS X. It will be launched by the operating system when you press Ctrl-R (Alt-R on Mac) at a predefined location. When the program is launched, it will offer you the possibility to add any executable file to its list. Once you add the file, a custom shortcut can be created. You can customize the key combination, the title of the shortcut, the command to launch the file and the icon to use. The name of the custom shortcut can be modified and the shortcut is saved in the same folder of the executable file. You can also delete the shortcut as well as all shortcuts created for the same file. When you install this program, it will create shortcuts for all the files found in the folder you chose at install time. A limitation of the program is that you cannot modify an existing shortcut. You can either create a new shortcut, or delete the old one. If you want to change the name of the shortcut, it is necessary to do it after its creation. To do that, you should find the shortcut from the Windows or OS X desktop, right click and select Rename shortcut. You can only display some information or copy it to clipboard, depending on the type of item you are modifying. In VersInfoEx, the same options are available in the Details tab of the application. Keymacro is an app that lets you record and replay keystrokes on your computer, allowing you to save time by avoiding to manually type in repetitive and boring text, also helping you with developing your writing and typing skills. The program uses the hardware Accelerometer to detect your keystrokes, so it needs to be installed on your device. Once you launch the app, you can record several keystrokes by pressing the record button on the top-left corner. Supported languages: English Deutsch Español Français Italiano Русский Keymacro is pretty easy to use, allowing you to record the keystrokes you make on your keyboard (QWERTY). The language support is quite impressive, as the program supports 44 different languages, including Spanish, Italian, German and French among others. More importantly, you can access the program settings and customize the keystrokes you want to record, including the language and the output format (e.g. "HTML or DOC"). Lastly, you can toggle the microphone function on and off. Keymacro lets you record keystrokes in batches The developer of the program also provides you with the feature to record several keystrokes simultaneously, ensuring you can save a lot of time. Once you press the record button, Keymacro will start recording, as well as displaying the date and time on top of the screen. To access the settings and customize the tool's settings, you need to click on the menu button that appears on the top-right corner. After you are done recording your keystrokes, click on the stop button to stop the recording process and view the recordings you made. As you can see, the program records them in a file with the extension.KEYMACRO, providing you with a nice time-saving method that will help you to cut down your work time as well as avoid any mistakes. What's in the Free Edition: Keymacro is a great time-saving tool that lets you record your keystrokes. However, the tool comes with a small price. In fact, you can only record your keystrokes in English, as well as record two keystrokes at once. Besides, the program does not display the date and time on top of the screen, which is not a big deal because it is easy to manually record a new date and time. Moreover, you can toggle the microphone function on
