The coin has been stored on an old rusty farm in Asker for at least five years, as the Norwegian authorities have revealed to local media. Authorities received a tip in July 2018 about the farm, which had a couple of other Bitcoin (BTC) wallets connected to it, according to Norwegian publication DR Nyheter. Local authorities executed a search warrant and seized the equipment on Nov. 27, 2018, after they were alerted to the farm by the exchange Trondheim Seksjon AS. The farm appeared to have been operating since at least 2015, as the newspaper Dagens Næringsliv reported. The land reportedly belonged to the former farmer, who died in 2011. His children continue to run the farm. Norway has previously been the scene of several other notable crypto-related crimes, including a massive \$6 billion hack in 2017. The country has previously been one of the most welcoming countries to Bitcoin. Recently, the country's second-largest mobile carrier announced that it would let customers make payments via Bitcoin.
