Police didn't disclose what led them to those claims. The mother who reported her daughter to police after learning of her pregnancy said she is pregnant because her daughter had sex for money. Her daughter said it was because of peer pressure. There were five other reports of people who were paid for sex in August. At least two of those paid for sex say they were victims of human trafficking, but none of those cases involved people 14 or under. "I know one was 14, I know one was 15 and I know one was 16," said Officer Laura Batten of the Sussex County Sheriff's Office. Human trafficking -- when someone is forced to have sex -- has been a problem in Delaware, Batten said. It is more prevalent in places like Newark, Camden and Wilmington. Last year, police made more than 200 human trafficking arrests, said Delaware State Police spokesman Sgt. Paul Shavack. "We did get several cases of human trafficking. We had a couple of people that actually had been bought and paid for. There was one case where a young lady was being forced to perform sexual acts for others for money," Shavack said. He said it's been a problem for years but that most of the cases involve adults. "We're seeing a lot of young girls, 14 and 15 and 16, being forced to do sexual acts for money." His agency also is investigating five human trafficking cases involving people under 18. A judge will decide whether there's enough evidence for the cases to go to trial, Shavack said. He didn't have the names of those under 18, because they haven't been charged. If police can prove a 14-year-old has sex for money, he said, "it's automatically a case of human trafficking."¹³ That means they are being subjected to exploitation by a third party for the purpose of sexual gratification or financial gain, which is against the law," Shavack said. Police say the cases involving teens are the result of human trafficking and that they're being properly handled.
