Keymacro is a standalone utility which enables the user to use keyboard shortcuts to run programs. For example, you might want to type "clockwork" on your keyboard to open Calculator, and on your computer to have the system beep or go to the desktop. (Actually, there are no system beeps for certain releases of Windows. The beep is a result of the OS adding a function to control how the computer sounds on demand. It can be turned off or reduced to an acceptable level.) Keymacro is more of a handy aid than a portable universal keyboard-shortcut master. In fact, it's very clunky. This is not

necessarily a bad thing, however. Not every shortcut must be built into every new program or tool. In fact, most features in new programs require configuration. For this reason, in the end, you might just want to buy a different program. As a quickie review of Keymacro, it does a good job at giving you a way to make all sorts of keyboard shortcuts from Windows applications. However, it's clunky and a real pain to use. On the positive side, it has plenty of potential users in Windows newbies. If you're willing to get a bit more involved, you can use the text file keyboard shortcuts.hkl. You can choose any shortcut you like on your keyboard and do it whenever you want. To use Keymacro, there are a few steps. First, you must download and install the software. I chose not to do this because in order for it to function, I had to

download another program. Once the installation is finished, you must associate your shortcuts.hkl file with the main application. The installation provides a check to make sure you have the right file. In fact, if you have a different type of keyboard-shortcut file, the program will warn you. You can't just double-click to use Keymacro. You must select the correct file from the file menu. Then, the computer will proceed to run the application, ask for your password, and let you make any changes to the shortcuts.hkl file. What I hate about the shortcut tool is that it saves the file with.hkl extension. The.hkl extension is just another extension that is added to the end of a file. Any.hkl file is an archived file. If you use any "archiving" program, you can open the file in your favorite text editor and edit it
